

Communication


 Through dual layered planning (management and team layer, milestones and activities)





Automation and integration

Instead of passive project management applications, think of active supporting project management tools

- From the purpose deviates the milestones
- From the milestones deviate the activities
- Those activities are distributed in workpackages
- Pushed in defined actions

- Integrating with communication tools
